

PARENT VIEW BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT CHART

FIRST WARNING > Student receives a verbal warning from the class teacher **CORRECTS BEHAVIOUR SECOND WARNING** > Second verbal warning STUDENT ATTENDS AN INTERVENTION MEETING WITH THEIR TEACHER, RECOGNISES THEIR POOR CHOICES **CONSEQUENCE** AND AGREES ON A POSITIVE WAY FORWARD ➤ Name on the board Intervention meeting with a task decided by the teacher ➤ On the tracker, the student's behaviour colour turns from green to amber for 24-48 hours **TIME OUT** THESE INTERVENTIONS GIVE THE STUDENT THE CHANCE TO REFLECT AND TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR THEIR **CHOICES DURING LEARNING TIME** > Isolation in Time Out Zone in the classroom Incident will be logged on the Tracker which will remain on amber for a longer duration and the Tutor, Head of Department, Head of Key Stage and parents will be informed ➤ Intervention meeting with Head of Department **TRACKED**

SUSPENSION AND PERMANENT EXCLUSION

> Student will now be tracked with a Behaviour Tracker

> Student's behaviour colour on the Tracker changes to red

Parents' meeting held with the Head of Senior School and Headmaster

Internal exclusion with Head of Senior School

IF THE STUDENT FAILS TO CORRECT THEIR BEHAVIOUR THEN THEY WILL FACE MORE SERIOUS CONSEQUENCES
